Associate Member Policy

The College of Alberta Denturists Bylaws provides for the membership category of Associate Member under the Other Members category.

Associate Members are prohibited from:

- a) serving as a member of Council;
- b) being appointed as a member of a Committee of the College; and
- c) voting at meetings of the College.

The category of membership in the College designated as Associate Member may be granted to an individual who:

- a) was previously a Regulated Member in good standing with the College, but is no longer registered with the College; and/or
- b) is a Regulated Member (licensed Denturist) in good standing with another Denturist Regulatory Body; and
- c) pays the applicable fees established pursuant to the Bylaws.

Associate Members cannot provide Denturist Services in Alberta and are not issued with a Practice Permit.

Associate Members will receive College Newsletters, notification of meetings, conventions and other general items distributed by the College from time to time or as directed by the Council.

If an Associate Member chooses to attend a College function to which there are applicable registration fees, etc, the Associate Member is required to register and pay such fees.

Associate Members are welcome to register for College functions and the Annual General Meeting of Members. Those Associate Members, who register and attend the Annual General Meeting of Members, must abide by the College's Other Members and Non-Members attending the Annual General Meeting of Members Policy.

This policy was reviewed and approved by Council on December 12, 2009.
