



STUDENT MEMBER INITIAL INFORMATION

This letter is to advise you of what a Student Member Registration with the College provides.

As you are in the process of educating yourself in the profession in the province of Alberta, it is appropriate for you to understand the legal requirements of the profession as indicated in the Alberta **Health Professions Act**. The College of Alberta Denturists is the regulatory body for the profession enacted under the **Health Professions Act** and as such, the College is the appropriate body to provide you with information related to the profession, categories of registration and related requirements for registration, and other such matters.

Further, if it is your goal to become registered and provide Denturist services in Alberta, this as a Regulated Member, you will be required to undergo College registration examinations.

By being a Student Member of the College, you will be advised (when appropriate), of upcoming examinations which you may be eligible to challenge. As well, the College will issue you with generic publications distributed to the profession; this includes our Wild Rose Denturist Newsletter which is a College publication for the profession in Alberta.

The College has its own website, which I invite you to view at: www.collegeofabdenturists.ca. The website provides two sides: a public side and a member's side. You will find on the public side, general information on the profession, the College, and regulation under the **Health Professions Act**. As well, there is a calendar of events and numerous publications. The member's side contains items for the members to view only; this will be available to a student member upon approval of their application for registration.
